



## Changes to tariffs

In decision D-2021-120, the Régie de l'énergie approved the application of **new provisional tariffs** for natural gas **transportation, load balancing** and **distribution** services effective October 1, 2021. A final decision on tariffs is expected and may change the variations presented.

After several favourable years during which customers were able to benefit from tariff reductions, the bill components are increasing, mainly due to factors external to Énergir.

## Effect on natural gas bill

The effect of the tariff changes on the bill considers the new transportation, load balancing and distribution tariffs and the respective prices of 15.308 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> and 4.682 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> for natural gas supply and the cap-and-trade system for greenhouse gas emissions<sup>2</sup>.

### For customers with distribution tariff D<sub>1</sub>

Effect of changes based on various annual consumption levels for tariff D<sub>1</sub> customers:

Annual consumption	Average variation for 2022 <sup>2</sup>
Between 0 m <sup>3</sup> and 1,095 m <sup>3</sup>	17.4%
Between 1,095 m <sup>3</sup> and 3,650 m <sup>3</sup>	17.9%

Although the variation observed over a year is high, on average the annual percentage increase in the bill for the last 6 years (2017 to 2022) remains below inflation.

Standard case	Annual variation 2017-2022 <sup>2</sup>
Residential - Recent 160 m <sup>2</sup> construction	1.2%
