

Environmental Policy



Énergir shall show leadership, rigour and determination in pursuing its environmental actions in its Québec natural gas distribution network operations (QDA) and at the natural gas liquefaction, storage and regasification plant. It is committed to doing the same with its customers and the general public in a context of sustainable development.

The company intends to take the necessary steps so that, beyond compliance with legislation and regulations applicable to the environment and with other applicable requirements to which it subscribes, it shall continuously improve its performance.

Énergir is committed to action in three following main areas:

Protection of the environment and prevention of pollution

- Responsibly manage its operations so as to control their negative repercussions on the environment
- Deploy environmental awareness-raising programs and training for employees
- Respect the principle of 3RV-E (reduce at the source, reuse, recycle, recover and dispose) in its waste management activities
- Apply energy-saving and water reduction measures to reduce its own consumption
- Consider the life cycle perspective in its value chain

Promotion of energy efficiency and reduction of pollution

- Reduce its own greenhouse gas emissions beyond the targets set in the commitments for Québec
- Promote energy efficiency and responsible consumption among its customers
- Encourage clean technology and the reduction of pollution through the conversion to natural gas

Collaboration with and consultation of interested parties

- Raise the awareness of its partners and suppliers regarding the adoption of environmentally sound business practices
- Hold stakeholder information and consultation sessions on the progress of its activities or major projects
- Get involved with and participate in the activities of organizations dedicated to protecting the environment
- Help develop public policies pertaining to energy and the environment

To this end, Énergir maintains and continuously improves an ISO 14001-certified environmental management system that enables it to identify consistent strategic orientations for the environment, to set environmental objectives and targets and to monitor the results obtained.
